

# Crochet Rain Frog No-Sew Pattern *(OK for Beginners!)*



Very easy to make and fun! For lovers of frogs, kawaii toys, and cute blobs. Perfect as a first project. 🌱

## Materials:

- Chunky yarn of your choice
- Matching hook
- Stuffing
- Safety eyes
- Stitch marker, or a safety pin, or a paper clip
- Black embroidery thread
- Embroidery needle (for thread and yarn)
- Scissors

## Abbreviations:

- Sc - single crochet
- Inc - increase
- Dec - decrease
- Bo - bobble stitch

## The frog:

1. 6 sc in a magic ring
2. Inc around (12)
3. Inc around (24)
4. 3 sc, inc - repeat around (30)
5. 4 sc, Inc - repeat around (36)
- 6-9. Sc around (36)
10. 4 sc, dec - repeat around (30)
11. 3 sc, dec, sc, bo

4 sc, dec, sc, bo

Repeat this sequence 2 times (26)

Now you've got the legs of the frog.

Place the eyes symmetrically at the centre of the frog, between stitches 7-8.

12. Sc, dec - repeat 9 times (17).

You will need to do the last decrease using the first stitch of the next row.

Stuff the frog at this point.

13. Dec - repeat 9 times (9).

You will need to do the last decrease

using the first stitch of the next row.

14. Weave at the end with embroidery needle, fasten off.

### **For mouth:**

Use embroidery thread and needle to make the mouth of the frog. Start below one eye and make a vertical stitch to the corresponding spot below the other eye. Then, pull and shape the stitch with the needle to make the grumpy appearance. At the upper point, fasten off the mouth with a thin black thread or a fishing-line.

### **For brows:**


Make brows with with black embroidery thread. Start at the inner centre of the eyes and make a diagonal stitch above the eye.

## For butt:

With black embroidery thread, make a diagonal stitch. Loosen it a little bit with the needle. At the centre of the stitch, start another stitch (shorter one) and direct it downwards. Shape it like a frog butt with the help of the needle.
