


### Llama jacket for 8 inch Heather Maciak dolls (Jenny and Lexie) or 8.5 inch Kruseling dolls

This llama jacket is knitted without seams, from below the waist up.

It has rib at the neck, bottom and cuffs and knit stitch edges down the front (of 4 stitches width either side), the llama fair-isle pattern is stocking stitch.

The button holes are knitted evenly down one of the knit stitch edges (some made at the start and others at the end of a row).

It can be knitted all in one colour or with the fair-isle llama pattern, using the coloured chart for the fair-isle pattern.

Each coloured square on the chart represents one stitch.

Use 2 ply wool and 1.5 mm (size 16 circular needles). 2 safety pins also required as stitch holders.

# Jenny and Lexie llama jacket

Sleeves (24 stitches)

The sleeves can be knitted flat, but preferably knit the sleeves in the round using 4 cable needles, picking up the stitches from the armholes.

If knitted in the round, there is no purl knitting in the sleeves.

Use 2 ply wool and 4 cable needles (1.5mm) http://dollmum.blogspot.co.uk/

Sew in all end threads into the inside and trim. Sew on 7 tiny buttons along the stocking stitch edge to match the button holes. Press with a cool iron.
