Flower Hat Pattern

Stitches used:

Magic circle

Chain (ch)

Single crochet (sc)

Half double crochet (hdc)

Double crochet (dc)

Treble crochet (tc)

Materials:

25g yellow (flower center and brim)

10g white (petal color)

40g background color

I used Loops & Threads Impeccable yarn size 4

5mm/size H hook

Darning needle for weaving in ends

Ch3 acts as first dc

- 1. In yellow, make a magic circle and chain 3 (or chain 4 and work into first chain), 11dc (12 stitches), ss and fasten off
- 2. Start with ch3 (In white, 2dc in same stitch, 1 dc. Switch to background color, 1 dc in same stitch) around. (24 stitches), end with ss in white.
- 3. Start with ch3 (In white, 2dc in same stitch, 1dc, 2dc in same stitch. Switch to background color, 1dc) around. (36 stitches), end with ss in white.
- 4. Start with ch3 (In white, 2dc in same stitch, 3dc, 2dc in same stitch. Switch to background color, 1dc) around. (48 stitches), end with ss in white.
- 5. This round creates the rounded petal edges. Don't carry along the background yarn this round. Don't ch3. (In white, 3dc into 2nd stitch, 3dc into 3rd stitch, 3dc into 4th stitch. Ss into last petal stitch, into background stitch, and into 1st stitch of next petal.) around. Fasten off white.
- 6. In background color, ch3. (2dc into petal edge, 2hdc, 1sc, 2hdc, 2dc. 1tc into background color section, making sure to cover the white ss from round 5. Ch2, 1tc into same stitch) around.
- 7. Dc around for 10 rounds (72 stitches)
- 17. In yellow (or whatever brim color) (2dc in same stitch) around (144 stitches)
- 18. (2dc in same stitch, 1dc) around (216 stitches)
