

Spa Scrubs

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Materials:

Tahki Yarns Sky (100% organic cotton, 50g/92yd) x 1
3.75mm crochet hook (F)

Body (make 2):

ch 4. slip st into first ch to make a loop.

Rnd 1: ch 2 (counts as first hdc), 5 hdc into loop. Join into the round with a slip stitch into the second ch of the ch 2 at the beginning of the round through the back loop (tbl). (6 sts)

Rnd 2: ch 2, hdc into same stitch, 2 hdc in each st through the back loop (tbl) until the end of the rnd. Join. (12 sts)

Rnd 3: ch 2, hdc into same stitch, [hdc into next st tbl, 2 hdc into next st tbl] until last st, hdc into last st tbl. Join. (18 sts)

Rnd 4: ch 2, hdc into same stitch, [hdc into next 2 sts tbl, 2 hdc into next st tbl] until last 2 sts, hdc into last 2 sts tbl. Join. (24 sts)

Rnd 5: ch 2, hdc into same st, [hdc into next 3 sts tbl, 2 hdc into next st tbl] until last 3 sts, hdc into last 3 sts tbl. Join. (30 sts)

Rnd 6: ch 2, hdc into same st, [hdc into next 4 sts tbl, 2 hdc into next st tbl] until last 4 sts, hdc into the last 4 sts tbl. Join and fasten off. (36 sts)

Edging:

Place two body pieces on top of one another, with right sides (side with circular ridges) facing out. Tuck ends in-between two body pieces. With new strand of yarn, make a sl st in two corresponding sts on each body piece.

Rnd 1: ch 1, sc into each st around (both body pieces at once). Join with sl st. (36 sts)

Rnd 2: ch 4 (acts as first dc and a ch1 space), [skip one st, dc into next st, ch 1] until the end of the round. Join with sl st into third chain of the ch 4 at the beginning of the round. Fasten off and weave in end.

The scrub will be a bit puffy at first, so you can either block it to lay it flat (a good idea if it's a gift) or just start using it yourself!

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
