

Knitting Simple Bow Pattern

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Thank you for purchasing my pattern!

Who does not like the idea of cute little bows ? They are relatively easy and fast to make compared to large projects such as shawls or cardigans. And they can be a perfect gift if you are looking for something special but yet quick to make ! They will definitely make any girl smile !

Materials:

I used 2 different yarn to make these bows .

1) Yarn: Manos Fino Mini 04 Dorothea / 05 Eleanor

70% new wool / 30% silk

450m/ 5 colors/ 20g per color/ 100g in total



Needles: 15cm HiyaHiya Bamboo Needles 2.75mm

Tension: Tension is not crucial for this project as long as stitches are not too loose.

One Size: 6cm * 5cm

Yarn amount for 1 bow: 3g

2) Yarn: Bc Loch Lomond

100% wool

50g/100m



Needles: 15cm HiyaHiya Bamboo Needles 3.5mm

Tension: Tension is not crucial for this project as long as stitches are not too loose.

One Size: 7cm * 6cm

Yarn amount for 1 bow: 4g

Knitting glossary :

K: knit

RS: right side.

WS: wrong side.

Sts: stitches

Pattern Instructions :

When you use hand dyed Manos yarn

Use 2.75mm 15cm dpn to cast on 10sts

Row1: Slip 1 purl wise, *k1, p1*, rep ** until last stitch, k1.

Rep row1 until it reaches 26cm .

When you use BC yarn

Use 3.5mm 15cm dpn to cast on 10sts

Row1: Slip 1 purl wise, *k1, p1*, rep ** until last stitch, k1.

Rep row1 until it reaches 30cm .

Changes you can make :

You can make bigger bow by casting on more stitches (any number is ok) .

Or you can make smaller bow by knitting shorter strip.

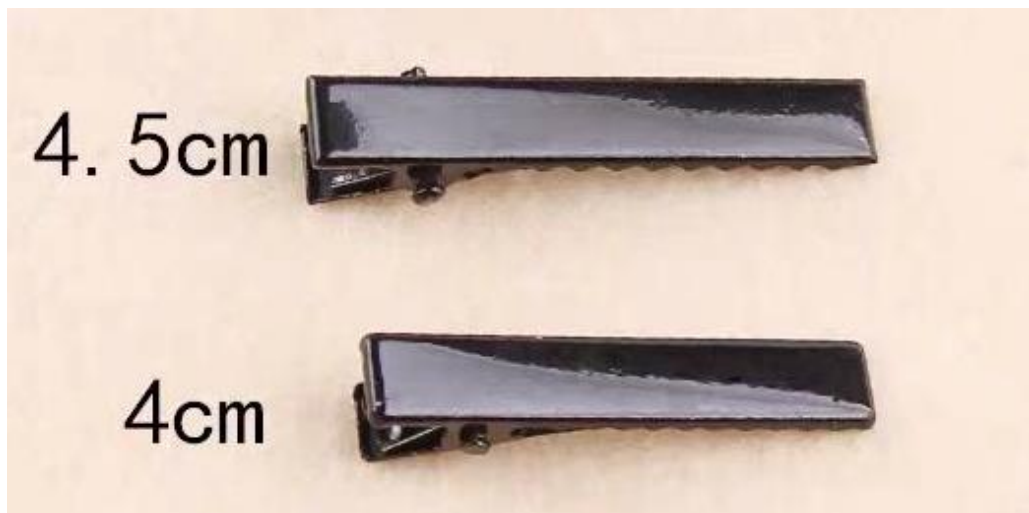
