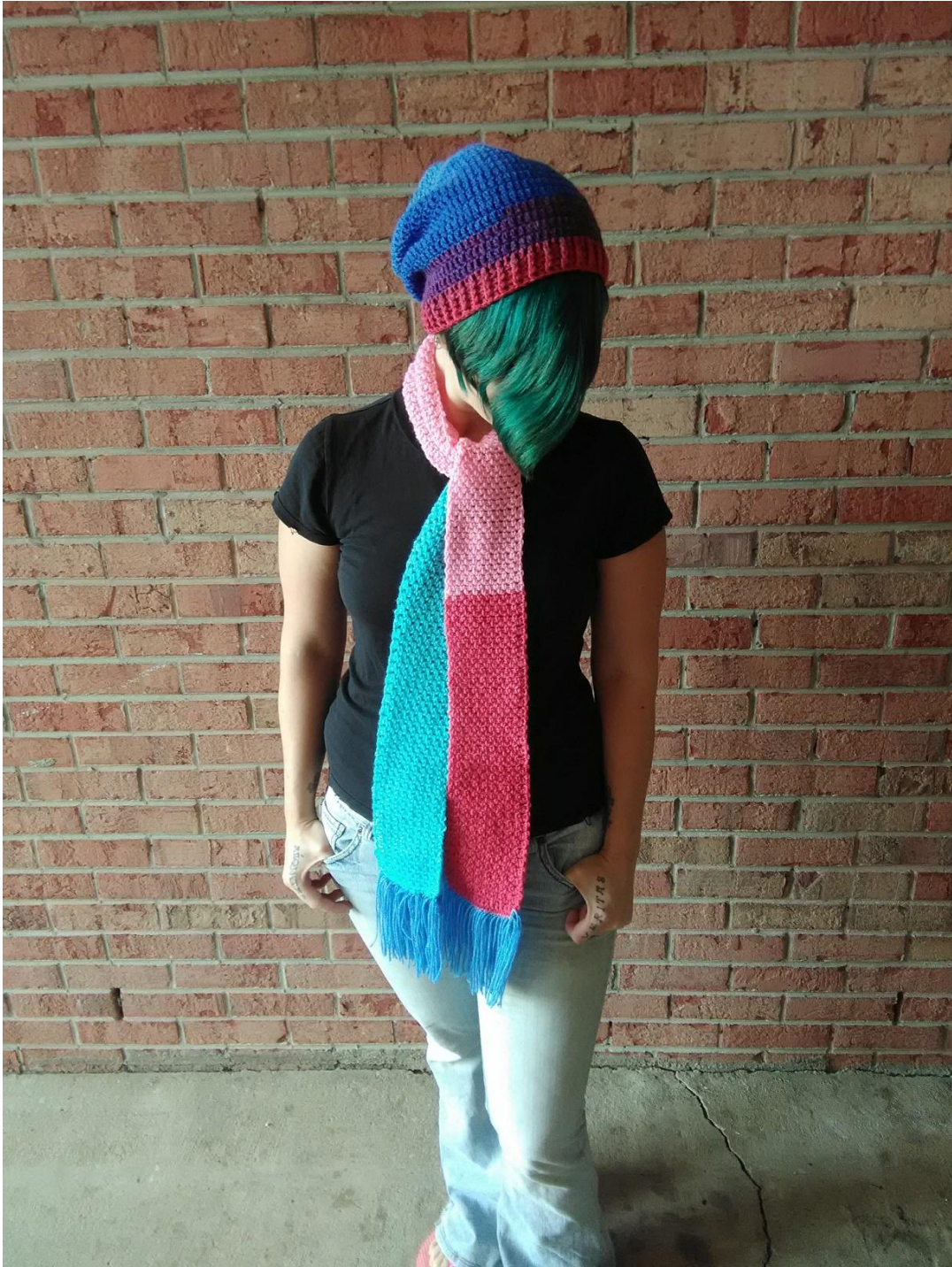




## Easy Crochet Beanie & Scarf





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### **Materials:**

US Size F/5 (3.75mm)

Approx. 500y Light-weight/3 Yarn (Shown: Lion Brand Mandala Cake in Phoenix)

Yarn Needle (for weaving in ends)

### **Final Measurements:**

Beanie circumference measures at 20"

Scarf measures at 4"x 60" (without fringe). Fringe measures at 4 ½" in length.

Stitches needed for projects: Chain stitch (ch), Double Crochet (DC), Front-Post Double Crochet (FPDC), Back Post Double Crochet (BPDC), Single Crochet (SC), Slip Stitch (sl st).

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### **Beanie**

Ch 4. Make 7 DC in first stitch of chain. Join with a sl st in first DC of the round. =8 DC  
(Note: This is the only instance where the chain at the beginning of the row counts in the round)

Row 1: Ch 2. Begin in next st: 2DC in each stitch to end. Join with a sl st in first DC of the round. =16DC

Row 2: Ch 2. \*2DC in next st, DC in following st, repeat from \* to end. Join with a sl st in first DC of the round. =24DC

Row 3: Ch 2. \*2DC in next st, DC in the next 2 st, repeat from \* to end. Join with a sl st in first DC of the round. =32DC

Row 4: Ch 2. \*2DC in next st, DC in the next 3 st, repeat from \* to end. Join with a sl st in first DC of the round. =40DC



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Row 5: Ch 2. \*2DC in next st, DC in the next 4 st, repeat from \* to end. Join with a sl st in first DC of the round. =48DC

Row 6: Ch 2. \*2DC in next st, DC in the next 5 st, repeat from \* to end. Join with a sl st in first DC of the round. =56DC

Row 7: Ch 2. \*2DC in next st, DC in the next 6 st, repeat from \* to end. Join with a sl st in first DC of the round. =64DC

Row 8 Ch 2. \*2DC in next st, DC in the next 7 st, repeat from \* to end. Join with a sl st in first DC of the round. =72DC

Row 9: Ch 2. \*2DC in next st, DC in the next 8 st, repeat from \* to end. Join with a sl st in first DC of the round. =80DC

Row 10: Ch 2. DC in each st. =80DC

Repeat row 10 until hat measures 10" in length.

Brim: Ch 2. \*FPDC in first DC from previous row, BPDC in next DC from previous row.

\*FPDC in next DC from previous row, BPDC in following stitch from previous row repeat from \* to end. Join row with sl st in top of FPDC at the beginning of the row.

Repeat row x2. Fasten off. Weave in ends.





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### Scarf

Ch 21.

Row 1: SC in 3<sup>rd</sup> st from hook. \*Ch 1, skip next st, SC in following st, repeat from \* to end. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 1. SC in first ch space, \*ch 1, SC in next ch space, repeat from \* to end. Turn.

Row 3: Ch 2. SC in first ch space, \*ch 1, SC in next ch space, repeat from \* to end. Turn.

Row 4: Ch 1. SC in first ch space, \*ch 1, SC in next ch space, repeat from \* to end. Turn.

Repeat rows 3-4, ending with row 4 when desired length is reached. Fasten off. Weave in ends. Add fringe/tassels/appliques as desired.
