Fan Wrist Warmers

Below you will find two nearly identical patterns. The first is for the shorter and a thick worsted weight (pictured is Loops & Threads Impeccable Ombre in Seaside) version (30 sts \times 12 rows). The second is for a light DK weight yarn (pictured is Patons Silk Bamboo in Almond) using a smaller hook and additional stitches around (36 sts \times 16 rows).

Additionally, you can easily change the length of either of these patterns by adding dc rows at the bottom for a wider cuff and/or additional Fan rows at the top (after row 12/16) or before the increase rows for the thumb (before row 7). I crochet fairly loose but if you need a larger or smaller size simply add or subtract 6 sts to the initial ch (6 sts per fan) or use a larger/smaller hook.

Also, I like to do my foundation chain with a hook one size up than the rest of the pattern to add stretchyness to the bottom.





Hook Size

G - 4.5 mm

Yarn Weight

4 / Worsted / Aran

Stitches & Abbreviations Used

Ch = chain Sk = skip

SI st = slip stitch Sc = single crochet Dc = double crochet Beg = beginning

Special Stitches

Fan: sk 2 dc, work 5 dc in sc, sk 2 dc, sc in next dc

Right Hand

Ch 30, join with a sl st

Rows 1-3 - Ch 2 (counts as first dc now and throughout), dc in next st and in each st to end.

Row 4 - Ch 1, *sk 2 dc, work 5 dc in next dc, sk 2 dc, sc in next dc,* rep from * to * around, ignoring last sc, sl st in beg ch to close ring.

Row 5 – Ch 2, work 2 dc in sl st, sk 2 dc, sc in next dc, 4 Fan, work 2 dc in sl st to complete beg Fan, sl st in 2nd ch to close ring.

Row 6 - Ch 1, 5 Fan, ignoring last sc, sl st in beg ch.

Row 7 – Ch 2, work 2 dc in sl st, sk 2 dc, sc in next dc, sk 2 dc, work 7 dc in sc, 3 Fan, sk 2dc, work 2 dc in sl st to complete beg Fan, sl st in 2nd ch to close ring.

Row 8 – Ch 1, sk 2 dc, work 7 dc in next sc, sk 3 dc, sc in next dc, sk 3 dc, work 7 dc in next sc, 3 Fan, sl st in beg ch to close ring.

Row 9 – Ch 2, work 2 dc in sl st, sk 3 dc, sc in next dc, ch 5 (for thumb hole), sk next 7 sts (3 dc, sc, 3 dc), sc in next dc, 3 Fan, sk 2 dc, work 2 dc in sl st to complete beg Fan, sl st in 2nd ch to close ring.

Row 10 – Ch 1, sk 2 dc, work 5 dc in sc, sk 2 ch, sc in next ch, sk 2 ch, work 5 dc in sc, 3 Fan, ignoring last sc, sl st in beg ch.

Row 11 - Repeat row 5

Row 12 - Repeat row 6

Fasten off, weave in ends.

Left Hand

Same as right hand through Row 6

Row 7 – Ch 2, work 2 dc in sl st, sk 2 dc, sc in next dc, 3 Fan, sk 2 dc, work 7 dc in sc, sk 2dc, work 2 dc in sl st to complete beg Fan, sl st in 2nd ch to close ring.

Row 8 – Ch 1, 3 Fan, sk 2 dc, work 7 dc in next sc, sk 3 dc, sc in next dc, sk 3 dc, work 7 dc in next sc, sl st in beg ch to close ring.

Row 9 – Ch 2, work 2 dc in sl st, 3 Fan, ch 5 (for thumb hole), sk next 7 sts (3 dc, sc, 3 dc), sc in next dc, sk 3 dc, work 2 dc in sl st to complete beg Fan, sl st in 2nd ch to close ring.

Row 10 – Ch 1, 3 Fan, sk 2 dc, work 5 dc in sc, sk 2 ch, sc in next ch, sk 2 ch, work 5 dc in sc, sk 2 dc, sl st in beg ch to close ring.

Row 11 - Repeat row 5

Row 12 - Repeat row 6

Fasten off, weave in ends.

E - 3.5mm

Yarn Weight

3 / DK / Light

Stitches & Abbreviations Used

Ch = chain Sk = skip

SI st = slip stitch Sc = single crochet

Dc = double crochet Beg = beginning

Special Stitches

Fan: sk 2 dc, work 5 dc in sc, sk 2 dc, sc in next dc

Right Hand

Ch 36, join with a sl st

Rows 1-3 - Ch 2 (counts as first dc now and throughout), dc in

next st and in each st to end.

Row 4 - Ch 1, *sk 2 dc, work 5 dc in next dc, sk 2 dc, sc in next dc,* rep from * to * around, ignoring last sc, sl st in beg ch to close ring. (6 Fans)

Row 5 – Ch 2, work 2 dc in sl st, sk 2 dc, sc in next dc, 5 Fan, work 2 dc in sl st to complete beg Fan, sl st in 2nd ch to close ring.

Row 6 - Ch 1, 6 Fan, ignoring last sc, sl st in beg ch.

Row 7 - Repeat row 5

Row 8 - Repeat row 6

Row 9 – Ch 2, work 2 dc in sl st, sk 2 dc, sc in next dc, sk 2 dc, work 7 dc in sc, 4 Fan, sk 2dc, work 2 dc in sl st to complete beg Fan, sl st in 2nd ch to close ring.

Row 10 – Ch 1, sk 2 dc, work 7 dc in next sc, sk 3 dc, sc in next dc, sk 3 dc, work 7 dc in next sc, 4 Fan, sl st in beg ch to close ring.

Row 11 – Ch 2, work 2 dc in sl st, sk 3 dc, sc in next dc, ch 5 (for thumb hole), sk next 7 sts (3 dc, sc, 3 dc), sc in next dc, 4 Fan, sk 2 dc, work 2 dc in sl st to complete beg Fan, sl st in 2nd ch to close ring.

Row 12 – Ch 1, sk 2 dc, work 5 dc in sc, sk 2 ch, sc in next ch, sk 2 ch, work 5 dc in sc, 4 Fan, ignoring last sc, sl st in beg ch.

Row 13-16 - Repeat row 5 & 6

Fasten off, weave in ends.

Left Hand

Same as right hand through Row 8

Row 9 – Ch 2, work 2 dc in sl st, sk 2 dc, sc in next dc, 4 Fan, sk 2 dc, work 7 dc in sc, sk 2dc, work 2 dc in sl st to complete beg Fan, sl st in 2nd ch to close ring.

Row 10 – Ch 1, 4 Fan, sk 2 dc, work 7 dc in next sc, sk 3 dc, sc in next dc, sk 3 dc, work 7 dc in next sc, sl st in beg ch to close ring.

Row 11 – Ch 2, work 2 dc in sl st, 4 Fan, ch 5 (for thumb hole), sk next 7 sts (3 dc, sc, 3 dc), sc in next dc, sk 3 dc, work 2 dc in sl st to complete beg Fan, sl st in 2nd ch to close ring.

Row 12 – Ch 1, 4 Fan, sk 2 dc, work 5 dc in sc, sk 2 ch, sc in next ch, sk 2 ch, work 5 dc in sc, sk 2 dc, sl st in beg ch to close ring.

Row 13-16 - Repeat row 5 & 6

Fasten off, weave in ends.
