



Minions Inspired House Slippers



A Guided Design Crochet Pattern



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FREE Crochet Pattern



Use:

5.0mm (H) crochet hook

Worsted weight yarn (Yellow, Black, Blue, Grey, White)

2 Black buttons (approx. 1" in diameter each)

Tapestry needle

Locking stitch markers (to mark the beginning of each round)

Dimensions of Final Product: (Pattern may be adjusted to accommodate different foot sizes)

Length: approx. 8.5"

Circumference: approx. 8"

Abbreviations (US Terms):

ch = chain sc2tog = single crochet two together

st(s) = stitch(es) (decreasing stitch, helps decrease the width of the

sl st = slip stitch project)

ea = each sc3tog = single crochet three together

FLO = front loop only (decreasing stitch)

sc = single crochet hdc2tog = half double crochet two together (decreasing stitch)

inc = increase (two of the same

dc = double crochet

rep = number of times to repeat

Instructions:

A. Slipper

Round	# of sts	Instructions
1	8	Start with yellow yarn 8hdc in a magic circle Tighten circle Join with sl st, ch 2
2	16	(1 hdc inc) 8rep Join, ch 2
3	16	1 hdc in ea st around Join, ch 2
4	24	(1 hdc, 1 inc) 8rep Join, ch 2
5	24	I hdc in ea st around Join, ch 2
6	27	(7 hdc, 1 inc) 3rep Join, ch 2
7	27	1 hdc in ea st around Change to black yarn Join, ch 2
8 – 9	27	1 hdc in ea st around Join, ch 2
10	27	1 hdc in ea st around Change back to yellow yarn Join, ch 2

11-14	27	1 hdc in ea st around Join, ch 2
15	27	1 hdc in ea st around Change to blue yarn Join, ch 2
16	20	(1 hdc, hdc2tog) 3rep 4 hdc 1 hdc2tog 3 hdc (1 hdc, hdc2tog) 3rep Join, ch 2, turn
17 - 26	20	1 hdc in ea st around Join, ch 2, turn
27	19	9 hdc hdc2tog 9 hdc The bulk of the slipper body is complete. You will now work on joining the seam of the heel

B. Joining the seam of the heel

The bulk of the slipper is complete. The next step is to close off the back of the slipper, to form the heel.

Take each corner of the last row, and fold the blue portion in half, hold the two corners together.

Working from top to bottom -

Insert hook into the inner loop of the top right stitch and inner loop of the top left stitch. You will now have 3 loops on your hook.

Yarn over and pull through all three loops on the hook. Repeat until you get to the bottom of the heel. Cut yarn and fasten off. Weave in all loose ends.
