# Elephant Appliqué



A Guided Design Crochet Pattern

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FREE Crochet Pattern



## Use:

5.0 mm (H) crochet hook  
Tapestry needle (to sew in ends)  
Locking stitch markers (to help keep count, if needed)

## Yarn:

Any worsted weight scrap yarn will do.

I used Big Twist Premium in Turquoise and Passion Flower

## Abbreviations (US Terms):

ch = chain

st(s) = stitch(es)

sl st = slip stitch

ea = each

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

## Helpful tip:

Use a locking stitch marker to mark the first stitch of each round to keep track of your work.

## Instructions:

The instructions are broken into two parts: the body and the ear.

For the body, I've broken down each round into how you will work in each stitch, with a total of number of stitches per round at the bottom.

## PART 1: Elephant Body

1	6	6 sc in a magic circle Join to first st with a sl st, ch 1
2	4	2 sc in ea of the first 2 sc
	2	2 hdc in the next sc
	4	2sc in ea of the next 2 sc

	12	Join to first st of round with a sl st, ch 1
3	1	1 sc in the first st
	2	2 sc in the next st

	24	Join to first st of round with a sl st, ch 1
5	3	1 sc in ea of the first 3 sts
	2	2 sc in the next st
	3	1 sc in ea of the next 3 sts
	2	2 sc in the next st
	3	1 sc in ea of the next 3 sts
	6	2 sc in the next st <b>Shaping first of two legs:</b> Ch 3, 1 hdc in 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> ch from hook, join with a sl st to next st (sl st is in 13 <sup>th</sup> st of prev round)



	1	1 sc in next st (14 <sup>th</sup> st of prev round)
	2	2 sc in the next st
	5	1 sc in the next st <b>Shaping second of two legs:</b> Ch 3, 1 hdc in 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> ch from hook, join with a sl st to next st (sl st is in 17 <sup>th</sup> st of prev round)
	2	1 sc in ea of the next 2 sts (18 <sup>th</sup> and 19 <sup>th</sup> st of prev round)
	2	2 sc in the next st
	3	1 sc in ea of the next 3 sts
	2	2 sc in the next st
	36	Join to first st of round with a sl st, ch 1
6	36	1 sc in ea st around Join to first st of round with a sl st, ch 1
7	16	<b>Shaping Head and Trunk</b> Turn 1 sc in ea of the next 7 sts (head shape) (shaping trunk) ch 8 1 sc in 2 <sup>nd</sup> ch from hook 1 hdc in ea of the next 6 ch join with a sl st to next st in round Fasten off, leave long tail to sew appliqué onto your work

## PART 2: Ear

Round	# of sts	Instructions
1	4	4 sc in a magic circle Tighten, ch 1, turn
2	8	2 sc in ea sc around (will resemble a half circle)
3	3	3 sc across the straight end Fasten off, leave long tail to sew to elephant Use a bit of the alternate colored yarn to sew a spot for the eye (refer to image at the beginning for reference)
