Rainfall Shawl



Knitting Pattern by Jo Creates

This super-simple knitted shawl looks effective in any variegated yarn.

Knitted using stripes of garter and stockinette stitch with sections of eyelets, this asymmetrical triangle shawl is simple to knit and easily adjusted with two size options given!



Suggested Yarn: 480-900m Koigu KPPPM (or any other fingeringweight Yarn) (Pattern is shown in Koigu KPPPM Colour 146)

Other Notions: tapestry needle for weaving in ends

Needle Size: 3.5mm

Gauge: Gauge isn't terribly important for this shawl but if you want

to check, 24sts x 15 rows in 10cm in stockinette

Finished Size: 110cm x 128cm (smaller size) 137 x 192 (larger size)

Suitable for: Advanced Beginner

Worked Flat

Casting on: Use the long-tail cast-on method

Abbreviations:

- ★ Knit (K)
- ♦ Knit front and back (KfB)
- ♦ Knit two together (K2tog)
- ◆ Purl (P)
- ♦ Purl front and back (PfB)
- Yarn Over (YO)


This pattern is made up from a very simple set of repeating sections or garter, stockinette and eyelets.

I've described how to make each section and then how to use these sections to make the shawl and stitch counts, etc.

Special note on the Eyelet Section:

I know that it is really easy to accidentally miss a KFB or PFB in these patterns and I wouldn't want you to worry, when you got to the eyelet section that you had to rip back to find the mistake.

The most important thing is that you have an odd number of stitches remaining on the needle when you start that section. If you get there and find that you are short a stitch or two or have an extra stitch or two, don't panic, just go one more or one less with the first Knit stitches so that you always have an odd number of stitches left, you won't notice one stitch more or less. To help you stay on-track, I've put stitch counts at the end of each section .







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Garter Section

Row G1: Kfb, K to end

Row G2: K to last stitch then Kfb in that last stitch

Row G3 to G16: Repeat row G1 and G2, 7 more times (8 times total)

Stockinette Section A

Row SA1: Pfb, P to end

Row SA2: K to last stitch, Kfb in that last stitch

Row SA3 to SA5: Repeat row SA1 and SA2 once then do row S1 a third time.

Eyelet Section

Note: This section is repeated a number of times but the number of K stitches on each row (shown by the [X]) will vary, see pattern below for details of how many stitches to do on each row

Row E1: K [x] stitches then *YO, K2tog, repeat from * to last stitch, Kfb into last stitch

Row E2: Pfb, P to end

Row E3: K [x] stitches then *YO, K2tog, repeat from * to last stitch, Kfb into last stitch

Row E4: Pfb, P to end

Row E5: K [x] stitches then *YO, K2tog, repeat from * to last stitch, Kfb into last stitch

Stockinette Section B

Row SB1: Pfb, P to end

Row SB2: K to last stitch, Kfb in that last stitch

Row SB3 to SB6: Repeat row SB1 and SB2 twice more

The Shawl

Cast on 4 stitches

Row 1-16: Garter Section (20 sts at end of section)

Row 17-21: Stockinette Section A (25 sts at end of section)

Row 22-26: Eyelet Section with following stitch counts (30 sts at end of section)

• Row 22: [x] for this row is K11

• Row 24: [x] for this row is K7

• Row 26: [x] for this row is K15

Row 27-32: Stockinette Section B (36 sts at end of section)

Repeat



133-100. Stockhiette Section B (104 sts at end of section



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Row 161-176: Garter Section (180 sts at end of section)
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Row 177-181: Stockinette Section A (185 sts at end of section)

Row 182-186: Eyelet Section with following stitch counts (190 sts at end of section)

- ♦ Row 182 [x] for this row is K71
- ◆ **Row 184:** [x] for this row is K67
- ◆ **Row 186:** [x] for this row is K75

Row 187-192: Stockinette Section B (196 sts at end of section)

Row 193-208: Garter Section (212 sts at end of section)

Bind-off here using your favourite stretchy bind-off.

If you want to make a larger shawl, don't bind-off and continue with Repeat 7-9 below

Row 209-213: Stockinette Section A (217 sts at end of section)

Row 214-218: Eyelet Section with following stitch counts (222 sts at end of section)

- Row 214: [x] for this row is K81
- Row 216: [x] for this row is K77
- **Row 218:** [x] for this row is K85

Row 219-224: Stockinette Section B (228 sts at end of section)

Row 225-240: Garter Section (244 sts at end of section)

Row 241-245: Stockinette Section A (249 sts at end of section)

Row 246-250: Eyelet Section with following stitch counts (254sts at end of section)

- Now 246: [x] for this row is K91
- **Row 248** [x] for this row is K87
- **Row 250:** [x] for this row is K95

Row 251-256: Stockinette Section B (260 sts at end of section)

Row 257-272: Garter Section (276 sts at end of section)

Row 273-277: Stockinette Section A (281 sts at end of section)

Row 278-282: Eyelet Section with following stitch counts (286 sts at end of section)

- **Row 278:** [x] for this row is K101
- **Row 280:** [x] for this row is K97
- ♦ **Row 282:** [x] for this row is K105

Row 283-288: Stockinette Section B (292 sts at end of section)

Row 289-304: Garter Section (308 sts at end of section)

Bind-off using your favourite stretchy bind-off
