## SKILL LEVEL:

Easy to Intermediate

# **FINISHED SIZE:** Size is customized.

Model is 24 rows + border and measures 20" across the top (not including ties) and 13" on each short side.

#### **MATERIALS:**

- Cotton DK weight yarn\* 100 yds. (91 m) was used for model
- Size 5/0 (3.00 mm) crochet hook *or* size needed to obtain gauge

#### GAUGE:

Working in pattern: 8 x 8 grid = 4" square




#### **SPECIAL STITCHES:**

Special stitches are defined and noted in *bold italics* for the first occurrence and/or defined in the Special Stitches section on page 2.

#### **BANDANA CHART**



#### BANDANA

Chains are always counted as stitches, unless noted otherwise.

#### **Row 1 (RS):**

Ch 7, dc in 5th ch from hook, dc in each of rem 2 ch.

#### **Row 2 (WS):**

[Ch 6, dc in 5th and 6th chs from hook, sk dc and next 2 sts, sl st in next ch – *beg block* made], [ch 3, 2 dc in ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch made of beg chs of prev row - *end block* made], turn.

#### **Row 3:**

Beg block, [ch 5, sk ch-sp, sl st and next 2 sts, sl st in next ch – *open space* made], end block, turn.

#### **Row 4:**

Beg block, 2 open spaces, end block, turn.

#### **Row 5:**

Beg block, 1 open space, [ch 3, 2 dc in ch-sp, sk sl st and next 2 sts, sl st in next ch - *block* made], 1 open space, end block, turn.

#### **Row 6:**

Beg block, 1 open space, 2 blocks, 1 open space, end block, turn.

#### **Row 7:**

Beg block, 1 open space, 1 block, [ch 4, 5 dc in ch-sp, drop lp from hook, insert hook from front to back in ch-4 sp just made, pick up dropped lp and pull thru, ch 1, sk sl st and next 2 sts, sl st in next ch – *Popcorn* made], 1 block, 1 open space, end block, turn.

#### **Row 8:**

Beg block, 1 open space, 4 blocks, 1 open space, end block, turn.

### **Row 9:**

Beg block, 1 open space, (1 block, 1 Popcorn) twice, 1 block, 1 open space, end block, turn.

### Row 10:

Beg block, 1 open space, 6 blocks, 1 open space, end block, turn.

#### Row 11:

Beg block, 1 open space, 1 block, 1 Popcorn, 3 blocks, 1 Popcorn, 1 block, 1 open space, end block, turn.

#### Row 12:

Beg block, 1 open space, 8 blocks, 1 open space, end block, turn.

#### Row 13:




Figure 1. Peaks and Valleys

Beg block, 1 open space, 1 block, 1 Popcorn, work blocks across until 3 valleys remain (*see Figure 1*), 1 Popcorn, 1 block, 1 open space, end block, turn.

#### Row 14:

Beg block, 1 open space, work blocks across until 1 valley remains, 1 open space, end block, turn.

Rep Rows 13 & 14 until the bandana is the desired width. Fasten off and weave in ends.

### **TOP BORDER & TIES**

Ch 45, or desired length of tie,

with RS of bandana facing, *join with dc* in last dc made on bandana,

ch 1, sc around dc just made, ch 3, sc *in center of sc* just made, hdc around same dc, sk next 2 sts, sl st in next ch,

♥ch 1, sc in next ch-sp, ch 3, sc in center of sc just made, hdc in same ch-sp, sk 2 sts, sl st in next ch,♥ rep from ♥ to ♥ across to last peak,

ch 1, sc in next ch-sp, ch 3, sc in center of sc just made, hdc in same ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch made of beg chs of prev row,

ch 45, or same length as first tie. Fasten off securely.

#### SPECIAL STITCHES

*beg block* – ch 6, dc in 5th and 6th chs from hook, sk dc and next 2 sts, sl st in next ch

*beg open space* – ch 8, sk dc and next 2 sts, sl st in next ch

block – ch 3, 2 dc in ch-sp, sk sl st and next 2 sts, sl st in next ch


*end block* – ch 3, 2 dc in ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch made of beg chs of prev row

*end open space* – ch 5, sk next 2 ch, dc in next ch

*open space* – ch 5, sk ch-sp, sl st and next 2 sts, sl st in next ch

**Popcorn** – ch 4, 5 dc in ch-sp, drop lp from hook, insert hook from front to back in ch-4 sp just made, pick up dropped lp and pull thru, ch 1, sk sl st and next 2 sts, sl st in next ch

*in center of sc* – work indicated st by inserting hook thru one horizontal bar and one vertical bar of sc (see photo for hook placement)



*join with* dc – with slip knot on hook, yo, insert hook in specified st, yo, pull up loop, (yo, pull thru 2 loops on hook) twice
