

C2C-Filet Coaster



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SKILL LEVEL:

Easy

FINISHED SIZE:

5" square

MATERIALS:

- Cotton worsted weight yarn* -20 yds (18 m) per coaster
- Size 7/0 (4.00 mm) crochet hook *or* size needed to obtain gauge

GAUGE:

Gauge is not critical for this project.


SPECIAL STITCHES:

Special stitches are defined and noted in *bold italics* for the first occurrence.



*Knit Picks Shine Worsted was used for models in the following colors: Hydrangea (#8056) and Green Apple (#6561).

COASTER CHART



COASTER

Chains are always counted as stitches, unless noted otherwise.

Rnd 1 (RS):

Ch 7, dc in 5th ch from hook, dc in each of rem 2 ch, ♥rotate work clockwise, ch 3, 2 dc around last dc made as if working into a ch-sp,♦ dc in ch at base of same dc (*first foundation ch*),♥ rep from ♥ to ♥ once more, then from ♥ to ♦ once, counting along foundation ch, join with sl st in first ch past 2 dc to form a square, turn.

Rnd 2 (WS):

Ch 6, dc in 5th and 6th chs from hook, sk 2 dc, sl st in next ch, ch 3, 2 dc in ch-sp, dc in next st – refers to same st as dcs worked around in prev rnd now and throughout, \P rotate work clockwise, ch 3, 2 dc around last dc made, sk 2 dc, sl st in next ch, ch 3, 2 dc in ch-sp, \P dc in next st, \P rep from \P to \P once more, then from \P to \P once, counting along beg ch, join with sl st in first ch past 2 dc, turn.

Rnd 3:

Ch 8, sk 2 dc, sl st in next ch, [ch 3, 2 dc in ch-sp, sk sl st and next 2 sts, sl st in next ch – *block* made], ch 5, sk ch-sp, dc in next st, ♥rotate work clockwise, ch 5, sk 2 dc, sl st in next

<u>C2C-Filet Hybrid Technique:</u> <u>Working in the Round!</u>

ch, 1 block, ch 5, sk ch-sp, \blacklozenge dc in next st, \blacktriangledown rep from \blacktriangledown to \blacktriangledown once more, then from \blacktriangledown to \blacklozenge once, join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch 8, turn.

Rnd 4:

Ch 6, dc in 5th and 6th chs from hook, sk 2 sts, sl st in next ch, [ch 5, sk ch-sp, sl st and next 2 sts, sl st in next ch — *open space* made] twice, ch 3, 2 dc in ch-sp, dc in next st, ♥rotate work clockwise, ch 3, 2 dc around last dc made, sk 2 sts, sl st in next ch, 2 open spaces, ch 3, 2 dc in ch-sp,♦ dc in next st,♥ rep from ♥ to ♥ once more, then from ♥ to ♦ once, counting along beg ch, join with sl st in first ch past 2 dc, turn.

BORDER (RS)

Ch 1, \forall sc in next dc, ch 3, sc in next dc, $\{$ sk ch-sp, (dc, ch 3, dc) in sl st, sk 2 sts, sl st in next ch $\}$ 3 times, (sc, ch 3, sc) in ch-sp, \blacklozenge sl st in next st, \blacktriangledown rep from \blacktriangledown to \blacktriangledown 2 more times, then from \blacktriangledown to \blacklozenge once, join with sl st in beg sc. Fasten off and weave in ends.
