SKILL LEVEL:

Easy to Intermediate

FINISHED SIZE:

5" wide x 5" high
(not including fringe)

MATERIALS:

- Cotton sport weight yarn*,
30 yds. (27 m) of each color per
coaster:
- Bright Pink (Color A - CA)
- White (Color B - CB)
- Size 5/0 (3.00 mm) crochet hook

GAUGE:

Gauge is not critical for this project.

SPECIAL STITCHES:

Special stitches are noted in **bold italics** for the first occurrence and defined in the Special Stitches section on pages 5 & 6.

*Knit Picks Shine Sport Weight yarn was used for models in the following colors:

- CA – Cosmopolitan (#5083)
- CB – White (#9437)

PATTERN NOTES

This is an overlay mosaic crochet pattern and is written in standard U.S. terms.

Additional terms have been created to define the double stitches. See Special Stitches section on pages 5 & 6 for detailed breakdown of these stitches.

All Osc are worked in both loops.

All sc are worked in the back loop only (BLO) unless noted otherwise.

All dc are worked into the front loop of the same color stitch two rows below the working stitch. Be sure to also skip the same number of stitches on the previous opposite color row.

All rows are worked on the right side. Join specified color, leaving a 4" tail at the beginning of each row. Fasten off at the end of each row leaving a 4" tail.

Design charts are included for reference on page 7.

It is the nature of overlay mosaic projects, being worked completely on the right side, to tilt slightly opposite the direction of crocheting. Periodically straighten the project by stretching to adjust the stitches. Blocking the finished project is also helpful.



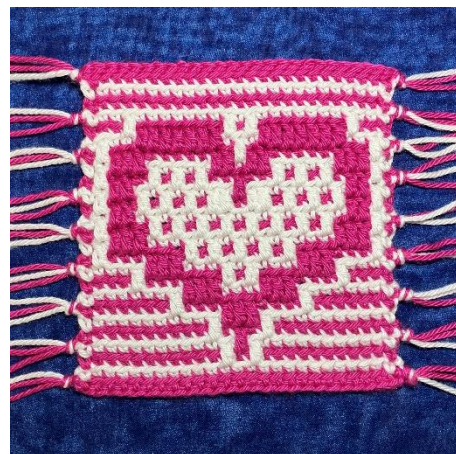

COASTERS

The front of the coaster is the same for all three options.



Typically, the back of an overlay mosaic project is striped with pockets behind the drop-down dc.



However, a design can be created on the back of the work by using just three different stitches to create the following three coasters:

- *Double Hearts Coaster* – A completely different design is created on the back.
- *Duplicate Hearts Coaster* – The design is the same on both the front and back.
- *Reverse Hearts Coaster* – The colors are reversed on the back and the design is shifted up one row.



DOUBLE HEARTS COASTER

For this coaster, the back portions of the DB and DD sts are worked into the **third loop** of the same color st two rows below the working st (refer to Special Stitches on pages 5 & 6).

The “Double Hearts Chart” (page 7) has been provided for reference.

Foundation Ch:

Using CA, ch 25 loosely.

Row 1 – CA:

Working in **back ridge of ch**, sc in each of 25 ch across.

Row 2 – CB:

Osc, scx23, Osc.

Row 3 – CA:

Osc, scx23, Osc.

Row 4 – CB:

Osc, scx5, **DB**x1, scx4, **DF**x1, scx1, **DF**x1, scx10, Osc.

Row 5 – CA:

Osc, scx11, **DF**x1, scx11, Osc.

Row 6 – CB:

Osc, scx4, **DB**x1, scx1, **DB**x1, scx2, **DF**x1, scx3, **DF**x1, scx9, Osc.

Row 7 – CA:

Osc, scx5, **DB**x1, scx4, **DF**x3, scx10, Osc.

Row 8 – CB:

Osc, scx3, **DB**x1, scx2, **DF**x1, **DB**x1, scx8, **DF**x1, scx6, Osc.

Row 9 – CA:

Osc, scx4, **DB**x1, scx1, **DB**x1, **DF**x3, scx3, **DF**x3, scx7, Osc.

Row 10 – CB:

Osc, scx2, **DB**x1, **DF**x1, scx1, **DB**x1, scx2, **DB**x1, (scx1, **DF**x1) twice, scx4, **DB**x1, scx1, **DF**x1, scx3, Osc.

Row 11 – CA:

Osc, scx3, **DB**x1, **DF**x3, **DB**x1, scx8, **DF**x3, scx4, Osc.

Row 12 – CB:

Osc, **DF**x1, **DB**x1, scx2, **DB**x1, scx1, **DB**x1, **DF**x1, scx1, **DD**x1, (scx1,



DFx1) 3 times, **DB**x1, scx1, **DB**x1, scx3, **DF**x1, Osc.

Row 13 – CA:

Osc, scx1, **DF**x1, **DD**x2, scx1, **DB**x1, scx1, **DB**x2, scx8, **DB**x1, scx1, **DF**x3, scx1, Osc.

Row 14 – CB:

Osc, **DF**x1, **DB**x1, scx2, (**DF**x1, scx1) twice, **DF**x1, **DB**x1, (**DF**x1, scx1) twice, **DF**x1, **DB**x1, **DF**x1, scx1, **DF**x1, **DB**x1, scx2, **DF**x1, Osc.

Row 15 – CA:

Osc, scx1, **DF**x2, **DB**x2, scx1, **DB**x2, scx8, (**DB**x1, scx1) twice, **DF**x2, scx1, Osc.

Row 16 – CB:

Osc, **DF**x1, scx1, **DB**x1, **DF**x1, scx1, **DD**x1, scx1, **DF**x1, **DB**x1, **DF**x2, scx1, **DF**x2, **DB**x1, **DF**x1, scx1, **DD**x1, scx1, **DF**x1, **DB**x1, scx1, **DF**x1, Osc.

Row 17 – CA:

Osc, scx1, **DF**x2, scx8, **DF**x1, (scx3, **DB**x1) twice, **DF**x2, scx1, Osc.

Row 18 – CB:

Osc, **DF**x1, scx3, (**DF**x1, scx1) twice, **DF**x1, scx4, **DB**x1, **DF**x1, (scx1, **DD**x1) twice, scx2, **DB**x1, **DF**x1, Osc.

Row 19 – CA:

Osc, scx1, **DF**x3, scx5, **DF**x2, scx1, **DF**x2, **DB**x2, scx1, **DB**x1, scx1, **DD**x2, **DF**x1, scx1, Osc.

Row 20 – CB:

Osc, **DF**x1, scx10, **DF**x1, scx1, **DB**x1, scx7, **DB**x1, **DF**x1, Osc.

Row 21 – CA:

Osc, scx3, **DF**x7, scx3, **DF**x2, **DD**x2, **DF**x1, **DD**x2, scx3, Osc.

Row 22 – CB:

Osc, scx2, **DF**x1, scx7, (**DF**x1, scx1) twice, (**DB**x1, scx2) twice, **DD**x1, scx2, Osc.

Row 23 – CA:

Osc, scx23, Osc.

Row 24 – CB:

Osc, scx23, Osc.

Row 25 – CA:

Osc, scx23, Osc.

Row 26 – CA:

Join with sl st in BLO of Osc, sl st in BLO of each rem 24 sts across. Fasten off.

Fringe:

Tie strands together, three at a time, in an overhand knot. Trim to desired length.

DUPLICATE HEARTS COASTER

For this coaster, the back portions of the DD sts are worked into the **third loop** of the same color st two rows below the working st (refer to Special Stitches section on pages 5 & 6).

The “Duplicate Hearts Chart” (page 7) has been provided for reference.

Foundation Ch:

Using CA, ch 25 loosely.

Row 1 – CA:

Working in **back ridge of ch**, sc in each of 25 ch across.

Row 2 – CB:

Osc, scx23, Osc.

Row 3 – CA:

Osc, scx23, Osc.

Row 4 – CB:

Osc, scx10, DDx1, scx1, DDx1, scx10, Osc.

Row 5 – CA:

Osc, scx11, DDx1, scx11, Osc.

Row 6 – CB:

Osc, scx9, DDx1, scx3, DDx1, scx9, Osc.

Row 7 – CA:

Osc, scx10, DDx3, scx10, Osc.

Row 8 – CB:

Osc, scx6, DDx1, scx9, DDx1, scx6, Osc.

Row 9 – CA:

Osc, scx7, DDx3, scx3, DDx3, scx7, Osc.

Row 10 – CB:

Osc, scx3, DDx1, scx6, DDx1, scx1, DDx1, scx6, DDx1, scx3, Osc.

Row 11 – CA:

Osc, scx4, DDx3, scx9, DDx3, scx4, Osc.

Row 12 – CB:

Osc, DDx1, scx6, (DDx1, scx1) 4 times, DDx1, scx6, DDx1, Osc.



Row 13 – CA:

Osc, scx1, DDx3, scx15, DDx3, scx1, Osc.

Row 14 – CB:

Osc, DDx1, scx3, (DDx1, scx1) 7 times, DDx1, scx3, DDx1, Osc.

Row 15 – CA:

Osc, scx1, DDx2, scx17, DDx2, scx1, Osc.

Row 16 – CB:

Osc, DDx1, scx2, (DDx1, scx1) 3 times, DDx2, scx1, DDx2, (scx1, DDx1) 3 times, scx2, DDx1, Osc.

Row 17 – CA:

Osc, scx1, DDx2, scx8, DDx1, scx8, DDx2, scx1, Osc.

Row 18 – CB:

Osc, DDx1, scx3, ♥(DDx1, scx1) 2 times, DDx1, ♥scx5, rep from ♥ to ♥ once, scx3, DDx1, Osc.

Row 19 – CA:

Osc, scx1, DDx3, scx5, DDx2, scx1, DDx2, scx5, DDx3, scx1, Osc.

Row 20 – CB:

Osc, (DDx1, scx10) twice, DDx1, Osc.

Row 21 – CA:

Osc, (scx3, DDx7) twice, scx3, Osc.

Row 22 – CB:

Osc, scx2, ♥DDx1, scx7, DDx1, ♥scx1, rep from ♥ to ♥ once, scx2, Osc.

Row 23 – CA:

Osc, scx23, Osc.

Row 24 – CB:

Osc, scx23, Osc.

Row 25 – CA:

Osc, scx23, Osc.

Row 26 – CA:

Join with sl st in BLO of Osc, sl st in BLO of each rem 24 sts across. Fasten off.

Fringe:

Tie strands together, three at a time, in an overhand knot. Trim to desired length.

REVERSE HEARTS COASTER

Do not join/anchor dcs, they will be joined on the following row with the DB st which is worked into the back loop of the same color st two rows below the working stitch to create the reverse design (refer to Special Stitches section on pages 5 & 6).

The "Reverse Hearts Chart" (page 7) has been provided for reference.

Foundation Ch:

Using CA, ch 25 loosely.

Row 1 – CA:

Working in *back ridge of ch*, sc in each of 25 ch across.

Row 2 – CB:

Osc, scx23, Osc.

Row 3 – CA:

Osc, scx23, Osc.

Row 4 – CB:

Osc, scx10, dcx1, scx1, dcx1, scx10, Osc.

Row 5 – CA:

Osc, scx10, **DBx1**, dcx1, **DBx1**, scx10, Osc.

Row 6 – CB:

Osc, scx9, dcx1, scx1, **DBx1**, scx1, dcx1, scx9, Osc.

Row 7 – CA:

Osc, scx9, **DBx1**, dcx3, **DBx1**, scx9, Osc.

Row 8 – CB:

Osc, scx6, dcx1, scx3, **DBx3**, scx3, dcx1, scx6, Osc.

Row 9 – CA:

Osc, scx6, **DBx1**, dcx3, scx3, dcx3, **DBx1**, scx6, Osc.

Row 10 – CB:

Osc, scx3, dcx1, scx3, **DBx3**, dcx1, scx1, dcx1, **DBx3**, scx3, dcx1, scx3, Osc.

Row 11 – CA:

Osc, scx3, **DBx1**, dcx3, scx3, **DBx1**, scx1, **DBx1**, scx3, dcx3, **DBx1**, scx3, Osc.



Row 12 – CB:

Osc, dcx1, scx3, **DBx3**, (dcx1, scx1) 4 times, dcx1, **DBx3**, scx3, dcx1, Osc.

Row 13 – CA:

Osc, **DBx1**, dcx3, scx3, (**DBx1**, scx1) 4 times, **DBx1**, scx3, dcx3, **DBx1**, Osc.

Row 14 – CB:

Osc, dcx1, **DBx3**, (dcx1, scx1) 7 times, dcx1, **DBx3**, dcx1, Osc.

Row 15 – CA:

Osc, **DBx1**, dcx2, (scx1, **DBx1**) 8 times, scx1, dcx2, **DBx1**, Osc.

Row 16 – CB:

Osc, dcx1, **DBx2**, (dcx1, scx1) 3 times, dcx2, scx1, dcx2, (scx1, dcx1) 3 times, **DBx2**, dcx1, Osc.

Row 17 – CA:

Osc, **DBx1**, dcx2, (**DBx1**, scx1) 3 times, **DBx2**, dcx1, **DBx2**, (scx1, **DBx1**) 3 times, dcx2, **DBx1**, Osc.

Row 18 – CB:

Osc, dcx1, **DBx2**, (scx1, dcx1) 3 times, scx2, **DBx1**, scx2, (dcx1, scx1) 3 times, **DBx2**, dcx1, Osc.

Row 19 – CA:

Osc, **DBx1**, dcx3, ♥(**DBx1**, scx1) twice, **DBx1**, ♥ dcx2, scx1, dcx2, rep from ♥ to ♥ once, dcx3, **DBx1**, Osc.

Row 20 – CB:

Osc, dcx1, **DBx3**, scx5, **DBx2**, dcx1, **DBx2**, scx5, **DBx3**, dcx1, Osc.

Row 21 – CA:

Osc, **DBx1**, scx2, dcx7, scx1, **DBx1**, scx1, dcx7, scx2, **DBx1**, Osc.

Row 22 – CB:

Osc, scx2, dcx1, **DBx7**, dcx1, scx1, dcx1, **DBx7**, dcx1, scx2, Osc.

Row 23 – CA:

Osc, scx2, **DBx1**, scx7, **DBx1**, scx1, **DBx1**, scx7, **DBx1** scx2, Osc.

Row 24 – CB:

Osc, scx23, Osc.

Row 25 – CA:

Osc, scx23, Osc.

Row 26 – CA:

Join with sl st in BLO of Osc, sl st in BLO of each rem 24 sts across. Fasten off.

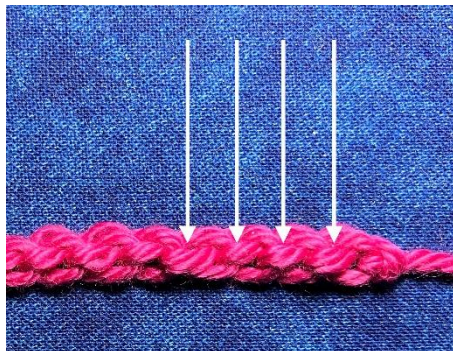
Fringe:

Tie strands together, three at a time, in an overhand knot. Trim to desired length.

♥♥♥ Special Stitches ♥♥♥

Back ridge of ch

Work sts in ridge on back side of ch as indicated by arrows:

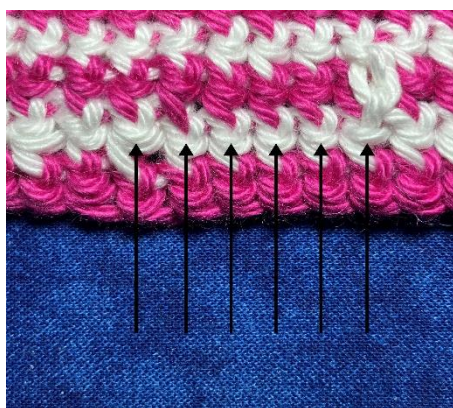


Osc - Outside sc

- *Beg of row:* with slip knot on hook, insert hook thru both lps of 1st st, yo, pull up lp, yo, pull thru all lps on hook.
- *End of row:* sc in both lps of last st, fasten off.

Third loop on back of stitch

Work sts into third loop¹, which is the horizontal bar on back of the stitch, located below back loop as indicated by arrows:



¹An extra loop is created when making the double stitches. Disregard this extra loop when determining the third loop so that all stitches in the back are worked into the horizontal bar making an even line across the back.

DB – Double stitch with drop-down in back

DB.1 Insert hook in back lp of opposite color st just below working st, yo,



DB.2 Insert hook in third lp² of same color st two rows below working st,



²For Reverse Hearts Coaster only: insert hook in back lp of same color st two rows below.

DB.3 Yo, pull up lp,



DB.4 Yo, pull thru 3 lps on hook (2 lps of working color and back lp of opposite color st)



DB.5 Yo, pull thru all lps on hook.



DF – Double stitch with drop-down in front

DF.1 Yo, insert hook in front lp of same color st two rows below working st,



DF.2 Yo, pull up lp,



DF.3 Yo, pull thru 2 lps on hook,



DF.4 Insert hook in back lp of opposite color st just below working st, yo,



DF.5 Pull up lp,



DF.6 Yo, pull thru all lps on hook.



DD – Double stitch with drop-down on both sides

DD.1 Yo, insert hook in front lp of same color st two rows below working st (see DF.1),

DD.2 Yo, pull up lp (see DF.2),

DD.3 Yo, pull thru 2 lps on hook (see DF.3),

DD.4 Insert hook in back lp of opposite color st just below working st, yo (see DF.4),

DD.5 Insert hook in third lp³ of same color st two rows below working st (see DF.2),

DD.6 Yo, pull up lp (see DF.3),

DD.7 Yo, pull thru 3 lps on hook (2 lps of working color and back lp of opposite color (see DF.4),

DD.8 Yo, pull thru all lps on hook.



³The third lp can be tight when working the DD stitch into an sc. If so, insert the hook from the side of the third lp and push out toward the center of the third lp.
