

FILLAN

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Size S is shown, and is good for a more snug adult fit. Size L gives a little more breathing room. This pattern is infinitely adjustable, so if you want a larger cowl, just add stitches in groups of 24. For more drape, add more groups and use thinner yarn.

Materials:

165 yards (225 yards) Tempted Luxe Grrl (Sport), “Sidra” or your substitute

4.0 mm/US6 Circular needle, 100 cm/40” long, or your choice for working in the round

Tapestry needle

Gauge: 4.5 stitches/inch, 9 stitches/5cm in pattern

Hold the two ends of your circular needles together and cast on 97 (121) stitches. Using both needles as one during the cast on will create larger loops for a clean yet stretchy edge. Set up your stitches for knitting in the round. Move your

first cast on stitch to the needle holding your last cast on stitch. At the end of the first round, you will work them together as if they are one stitch, eliminating any “jog” on your edge.

Follow the chart or written instructions on page 2. Each round will have 4 (5) repeats of the pattern. If you added more groups of 24 to your cast on, you will have the corresponding number of additional repeats.

Work Rows 1-16 4 times. If you have chosen a larger yarn, you may wish to only work the rows 3 times.

Work row 1 once more, binding off as you go. You want this to be as stretchy as possible. I highly recommend Jeny’s Surprisingly Stretchy Bind Off, described here for the unfamiliar: knitty.com/ISSUEfall09/FEATjssbo.php.

Weave in ends and block for clean lines.

 R7: k2, p3, k5, p2, k2, p1, k2, p3, k2, p2
