# Diagonal Blanket 

## Sizes:

One size.
Finished Measurements:
60 " long $\times 48^{\prime \prime}$ wide

## Yarn:

Shown in Classic Elite's Phoenix (32\% mohair, 8\% wool, 52\% nylon, 8\% acrylic; 50 gram ball $=$ approx 88 yards) 4 balls each 6672 Parrot's Tail (A), 6634 Pink Plume (B), 6685 Orange Ostrich (C), 6657 Blue Velvet (D), or approx 352 yards in 4 colors of a comparable yam.

## Knitting Needles:

one 40" circular size US 10 ( 6 mm )
Or size to obtain gauge.

## Gauge:

12 sts and 22 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}$ in Gtr St
Take time to save time, check your gauge.

## Blanket:

With A, CO 6 sts.
Knit 2 rows, ending after a WS row.

Inc Row: K3, yo, knit to end - 1 st inc'd.
Rep inc row every row 41 more times, ending after a WS row - 48 sts.

Change to color B.
Work inc row 44 times - 92 sts.
Change to color C .
Work inc row 44 times - 136 sts.
Change to color D.
Work inc row 44 times - 180 sts.

Change to color A.
How 1: (RS) K2, k2tog, yo, k2tog, knittoend
Row 2: (WS) K3, yo, knit to end of row
Rep the previous 2 rows 21 more times,
ending after a WS row.


Change to color B
Dec Row: K2, k2tog, yo, k2tog, knit to end - 1 st dec'd.
Rep dec row 43 more times, ending after a WS row-136 sts rem.

Change to color C
Work dec row 44 times - 92 sts rem.
Change to color D.
Work dec row 44 times - 48 sts rem.
Change to color A.
Work dec row 42 times - 6 sts rem.

Knit 2 rows.
BO all sts knitwise.

## Notes:

- Circular needle is used to accommodate large number of sts.
- To easily tell the RS from the WS, place a marker, or tie a piece of yarn on the RS of the blanket.


## Abbreviations

approx: approximately
BO: bind off
CO: cast on
dec('d): decreas(ed)
Gtr St: knit all sts, every row.
inc('d): increas(ed)
k2tog: knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
rem: remain(ning)
rep: repeat
RS: right side
st(s): stitch(es)
WS: wrong side
yo: yarn over (1 st inc'd)
