

# Classic Elite Yarns

## Soft Linen Apple Cozy



**Designed by:** Kristen TenDyke

**SIZE:** One Size

**Finished Measurements:**

4¾" long x 10" circumference

### **MATERIALS:**

**Soft Linen** by **Classic Elite** (35% linen, 35% wool, 30% baby alpaca; 50 gram ball = approx 137 yards)

- 1 ball 2285 Cathay

### **Crochet Hook**

- One G/6 (4 mm)

### **Or size to obtain gauge**

- Tapestry needle

**GAUGE:** 18 sts and 15 rows = 4" in Half Double Crochet. **Take time to save time, check your gauge.**

### **PATTERN STITCHES:**

**Chain (ch):** Begin by making a slip knot on your hook. Wrap the yarn around the hook (yarn over) and draw it through the loop on the hook to form the first chain. Rep this step as many times as instructed. (The loop on the hook is never included when counting the number of chains).

**Slip Stitch (slip st):** Insert hook in the indicated stitch, yarn over and draw through both the stitch and the loop on the hook.

**Half Double Crochet (hdc):** Yarn over hook, insert hook into indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop; yarn over and draw through all three loops on hook.

**Single Crochet (sc):** Insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop; yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

### **COZY**

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as ch-1, hdc), hdc 11 into first ch, sl st into tch to join—12 hdc.

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), hdc into same st as sl st, hdc in next hdc, \*2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in next hdc; rep from \* around, sl st in tch to join—18 hdc.

Rnd 3: Rep Rnd 2—27 hdc.

Rnd 4: Ch 2, hdc into same st as sl st, hdc in next 2 hdc, \*2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in next hdc; rep from \* around, sl st in tch to join—40 hdc.

Rnd 5: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around, sl st in tch to join.

Rnd 6: Ch 2, hdc into same st as sl st, hdc into each of next 7 hdc, \*2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in each of next 7 hdc; rep from \* around, sl st in tch to join—45 hdc.

Rnds 7–15: Rep Rnd 5.



Rnd 16: (Eyelet Rnd) Ch 2, hdc in next hdc, ch 1, sk 1 hdc, \*hdc in next 2 hdc, ch 1, sk 1 hdc; rep from \* around, sl st in tch to join—15 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 17: Ch 2, hdc in next hdc, hdc in ch-1 sp, \*hdc in each of next 2 hdc, hdc in ch-1 sp; rep from \* around, sl st to tch to join—45 hdc.

Rnd 18: Rep Rnd 5.

Fasten off.

### **TIE**

Ch 76, turn. Sk 1 ch, sc in next ch and each ch across—75 sc. Fasten off.

### **FINISHING**

Slip tie through eyelets at top of Cozy. There is 1 extra hole, do not insert tie through the last hole.

**approx**—approximately

**ch**—chain

**hdc**—half double crochet

**rep**—repeat

**rnd**—round

**sc**—single crochet

**sk**—skip

**sl st**—slip stitch

# Classic Elite Yarns

## Soft Linen Banana Cozy

**SIZE:** One Size

**Finished Measurements:**

8½" long x 5¼" circumference

### MATERIALS:

**Soft Linen** by **Classic Elite** (35% linen, 35% wool, 30% baby alpaca; 50 gram ball = approx 137 yards)

- 1 ball 2250 Inca Gold

### Crochet Hook

- One G/6 (4 mm)

**Or size to obtain gauge**

- Tapestry needle

**GAUGE:** 18 sts and 15 rows = 4" in Half Double Crochet. **Take time to save time, check your gauge.**

### PATTERN STITCHES:

**Chain (ch):** Begin by making a slip knot on your hook. Wrap the yarn around the hook (yarn over) and draw it through the loop on the hook to form the first chain. Rep this step as many times as instructed. (The loop on the hook is never included when counting the number of chains).

**Slip Stitch (sl st):** Insert hook in the indicated stitch, yarn over and draw through both the stitch and the loop on the hook.

**Half Double Crochet (hdc):** Yarn over hook, insert hook into indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop; yarn over and draw through all three loops on hook.

**Single Crochet (sc):** Insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop; yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

### COZY

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as ch-1, hdc), hdc 7 into first ch, sl st into tch to join—8 hdc.

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), hdc into same st as sl st, hdc in next hdc, \*2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in next hdc; rep from \* around, sl st in tch to join—12 hdc.

Rnd 3: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around, sl st in tch to join.

Rnd 4: Ch 2, hdc in same st as sl st, hdc in next 2 hdc, \*2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in next 2 hdc; rep from \* around, sl st in tch to join—16 hdc.

Rnd 5: Rep Rnd 3.

Rnd 6: Ch 2, hdc in same st as sl st, hdc in next 3 hdc, \*2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in next 3 hdc; rep from \* around, sl st in tch to join—20 hdc.

Rnd 7: Rep Rnd 3.

Rnd 8: Ch 2, hdc in same st as sl st, hdc in next

4 hdc, \*2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in next 4 hdc; rep from \* around, sl st in tch to join—24 hdc. Rnds 9–29: Rep Rnd 3.

Rnd 30: (Eyelet Rnd) Ch 2, hdc in next hdc, ch 1 sk 1 hdc, \*hdc in each of next 2 hdc, ch 1, sk 1 hdc; rep from \* around, sl st in tch to join—8 ch-1 sps

Rnd 31: Ch 2, hdc in next hdc, hdc in ch-1 sp, \*hdc in next 2 hdc, hdc in ch-1 sp; rep from \* around, sl st to tch to join—24 hdc.

Rnd 32: Rep Rnd 3.

Fasten off.

### TIE

Ch 76, turn. Sk 1 ch, sc in next ch and each ch across—75 sc. Fasten off.

### FINISHING

Slip tie through eyelets at top of Cozy.

# Classic Elite Yarns

## Soft Linen Pear Cozy

SIZE: One Size

**Finished Measurements:**

4¾" long x 8¾" circumference

**MATERIALS:**

**Soft Linen** by **Classic Elite** (35% linen, 35% wool, 30% baby alpaca; 50 gram ball = approx 137 yards)

- 1 ball 2281 New Fern

**Crochet Hook**

- One G/6 (4 mm)

**Or size to obtain gauge**

- Tapestry needle

**GAUGE:** 18 sts and 15 rows = 4" in Half Double Crochet. **Take time to save time, check your gauge.**

**PATTERN STITCHES:**

**Chain (ch):** Begin by making a slip knot on your hook. Wrap the yarn around the hook (yarn over) and draw it through the loop on the hook to form the first chain. Rep this step as many times as instructed. (The loop on the hook is never included when counting the number of chains).

**Slip Stitch (slip st):** Insert hook in the indicated stitch, yarn over and draw through both the stitch and the loop on the hook.

**Half Double Crochet (hdc):** Yarn over hook, insert hook into indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop; yarn over and draw through all three loops on hook.

**Single Crochet (sc):** Insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop; yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

**COZY**

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as ch-1, hdc), hdc 11 into first ch, sl st into tch to join—12 hdc.

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), hdc into same st as sl st, hdc in next hdc, \*2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in next hdc; rep from \* around, sl st in tch to join—18 hdc.

Rnd 3: Rep Rnd 2—27 hdc.

Rnd 4: Ch 2, hdc into same st as sl st, hdc in each of next 2 hdc, \*2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in each of next 2 hdc; rep from \* around, sl st in tch to join—36 hdc.

Rnd 5: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around, sl st in tch to join.

Rnd 6: Rep Rnd 5.

Rnd 7: Ch 2, hdc into same st as sl st, hdc in each of next 11 hdc, \*2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in each of next 11 hdc; rep from \* around,



sl st in tch to join—39 hdc.

Rnds 8–15: Rep Rnd 5.

Rnd 16: (Eyelet Rnd) Ch 2, hdc in next hdc, ch 1, sk 1 hdc, \*hdc in each of next 2 hdc, ch 1, sk 1 hdc; rep from \* around, sl st in tch to join—13 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 17: Ch 2, hdc in next hdc, hdc in ch-1 sp, \*hdc in next 2 hdc, hdc in ch-1 sp; rep from \* around, sl st to tch to join—39 hdc.

Rnd 18: Rep Rnd 5.

Fasten off.

**TIE**

Ch 76, turn. Sk 1 ch, sc in next ch and each ch across—75 sc. Fasten off.

**FINISHING**

Slip tie through eyelets at top of Cozy. There is 1 extra hole, do not insert tie through the last hole.
