Body:

Work in a spiral, marking the beginning of each round so you don't get lost.

Rnd1	6 sc in magic ring (6 sc)
Rnd2	6 inc. (12 sc)
Rnds	(1 sc, 1 inc) Rep. (18 sc)
Rnd4	(2 sc, 1 inc.) Rep. (24 sc)
Rnd5	(3 sc, 1 inc.) Rep. (30 sc)
Rnd6	(4 pb, 1 inc.) Rep. (36 sc)
Rnd7 to Rnd12	1 sc in each sc (36 sc). Place the eyes between Rnd10 and Rnd11.
Rnd13	(4 sc, 1 dec) Rep (30sc)
RNd14	(3 sc, 1 dec) Rep (24sc)

Materials

2,5 mm Crochet Hook
Scissors
yarn needle
A pair of 8 mm safety eyes
Polyester fiberfill for stuffing
Keychain ring

Light weight yarn in pink.

NOTES: When spiral weaving, finish the last round with three slip stithc to match the fabric.

	RNd15	(2 sc, 1 dec) Rep (18 sc) - stuff.		
	Rnd16	(1 sc, 1 dec) Rep (12 sc)		
	RNd17	6 dec		
Fasten off				



TENTACLES:

Start with 16 ch and joun the last ch with the first one to make a circle, this is going to be our tentacles base.

15 ch, in the second sc form the kooh make 3 dc in next 14 ch (42 dc)

Sk 1 ch from the base, 1 sl st in the next ch.

Repeat these two steps all around the circle's base until we have the 8 tentacles.

NOTES: Once you finish the parts, sew the tentacles at the bottom part of the body and add a lace of ch at the top of the

head to join the keychain ring.
