Instructions:

Body:

Work in a spiral, marking the beginning of each round so you don't get lost.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Rnd1	6 sc in magic ring (6 sc)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rnd2	6 inc. (12 sc)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rnd3	(1 sc, 1 inc) Rep. (18 sc)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rnd4	(2 sc, 1 inc.) Rep. (24 sc)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rnd5	(3 sc, 1 inc.) Rep. (30 sc)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rnd6	(4 pb, 1 inc.) Rep. (36 sc)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rnd7 to Rnd12	1 sc in each sc (36 sc). Place the eyes between Rnd10 and Rnd11.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rnd13	(4 sc, 1 dec) Rep (30sc)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rnd14	(3 sc, 1 dec) Rep (24sc)

Terminology

Ch: chain / chains

st: stitch / stitches

sc: single crochet

sl st: slip stitch

hdc: half double crochet

dc: double crochet

bpsc: back post single crochet

BLO: back loops only

FLO: front loops only

inc. Increase

dec: decrease

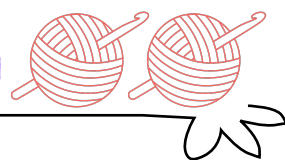
Rnd: round

Rep: Repeat

Materials

<input type="checkbox"/>	Light weight yarn in pink.
<input type="checkbox"/>	2,5 mm Crochet Hook
<input type="checkbox"/>	Scissors
<input type="checkbox"/>	yarn needle
<input type="checkbox"/>	A pair of 8 mm safety eyes
<input type="checkbox"/>	Polyester fiberfill for stuffing
<input type="checkbox"/>	Keychain ring

NOTES: When spiral weaving, finish the last round with three slip stithc to match the fabric.

Body (...continuation):

<input type="checkbox"/>	Rnd15	(2 sc, 1 dec) Rep (18 sc) - stuff.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rnd16	(1 sc, 1 dec) Rep (12 sc)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rnd17	6 dec

Fasten off.

TENTACLES:

Start with 16 ch and join the last ch with the first one to make a circle, this is going to be our tentacles base.

- ☐ 15 ch, in the second sc form the hook make 3 dc in next 14 ch (42 dc)
- ☐ Sk 1 ch from the base, 1 sl st in the next ch.

Repeat these two steps all around the circle's base until we have the 8 tentacles.



NOTES: Once you finish the parts, sew the tentacles at the bottom part of the body and add a lace of ch at the top of the head to join the keychain ring.
