## intructions:

## Body:

Work in a spiral, marking the beginning of each round so you don't get lost.


| Materials |  |
| :--- | :--- |
| $\square$ | Light weight yarn in pink. |
| $\square \square$ | 2,5 mm crochet Hook |
| $\square$ | scissors |
| $\square$ | yarn needle |
| $\square$ | Apair of 8 mm safety eyes |
| $\square$ | Polyester fiberfill for stuffing |
| $\square$ | Keychain ring |

NOTES: When spiral weaving, finish the last round with three slip stithy to match the fabric.

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Fasten off.



## TENTACLES:

Start with 16 ch and join the last ch with the first one to make a circle, this is going to be our tentacles base.

| $\square$ | 15 ch, in the second sc form the Ron <br> make 3 dc in next $14 \mathrm{ch}(42 \mathrm{dc})$ |
| :--- | :--- |
| $\square$ | sk 1 ch from the base, 1 st st in the <br> next ch. |

Repeat these two steps all around the cirche's base until we have the 8 tentacles.


NOTES: Once you finish the parts, sew the tentacles at the bottom part of the body and add a lace of ch at the top of the
