

Boxy Cozy

This cup cozy is knit in the popular waffle stitch pattern of the Boxy Dishcloth. This time, a superwash merino wool is used for warmth, while also making it machine washable for any coffee or tea spills!

Stitch Guide

Waffle Stitch Pattern (worked in the round):

Rnd 1: *K2, p1; rep from * to end. Rnd 2: *K2, p1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 3: *K2, p1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 4: Purl to end of rnd.

Rep Rnds 1-4 for patt.

Knitting Instructions

Cast on 36 sts. Arrange sts evenly on 3 dpn, place marker (pm), and join for working in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

Work Rnds 1 - 4 of Waffle Stitch Pattern (see Stitch Guide) 6 times for the regular size or 8 times for large. Then work Rnds 1 - 3 once more.

Bind off all sts in patt (knit the knit sts and purl the purl sts while binding off) loosely and weave in ends.

Yarn

Cascade Yarns 220 Superwash Sport (100% superwash merino wool; 136 yd [124 m]/50 grams). Approximately 25 yards are required for the regular size cozy and 32 yards for large. Shown in #818 (brown) and #1946 (gray).

Needles

One set size 6 (4.0 mm) double pointed (dpn) or size needed to obtain gauge.

Gauge

11 sts and 17 rnds = 2 inches in Waffle Stitch Pattern worked in the round.

Measurements

Regular size cozy = 3 1/4 in. tall, unstretched. Large cozy = 4 1/4 in. tall, unstretched. Both cozies fit most common hot drink cups.

Washing Instructions

Machine wash cool. Tumble dry low.
