



Lil Bit of Sunshine's

Cascade Beanie Pattern

What you will need:

- **Worsted Weight Yarn**
(Red Heart SuperSaver in Aqua used in the picture above.)
- **5.0 mm hook - H hook**
- **Yarn needle or Smaller Hook**
(For finishing/hiding the ends)



Gauge:

Using dc stitch:
10 stitches x 3 rows = 3 in x 2 in

Need to know Stitches and Abbreviations:

- ch = chain
- sc = single crochet
- dc = double crochet
- sc inc = single crochet increase
- dc inc = double crochet increase
- sl st = slip stitch
- st = stitch
- sk = skip

Notes:

- Use (sc, ch 1) as beginning dc stitch.
- Rows 8-15 stitches should be stitched in the middle of the dc inc/sc inc.
- The # after st means to use that st in the next # specified.
EX: dc 3 = double crochet in the next 3 stitches
- Any stitches between the * are to be repeated until the end of the row.

Begin using your choice of method:

Magic Circle

Or

Ch 4, sl st in the 1st st to join;

Row 1 - sc, ch 1. dc 11 in magic circle or ch circle, sl st in the ch 1 to join;

Row 2 - sc, ch 1, dc in the same st, dc inc in each st around, sl st in the ch 1 to join;

Row 3 - sc, ch 1, dc in the same st, dc, *dc inc, dc,* repeat around, sl st in the ch 1 to join;

Row 4 - sc, ch 1, dc in the same st, dc 2, *dc inc, dc 2,* repeat around, sl st in the ch 1 to join;

Row 5 - sc, ch 1, dc in the same st, dc 3, *dc inc, dc 3,* repeat around, sl st in the ch 1 to join;

Row 6 - sc around;

Row 7-14 - sc, ch 1, dc in the same st, sk 1, *dc inc, sk 1,* repeat around, sl st in the ch 1 to join;

Row 15 - *sc inc, sk 1,* repeat around, sl st in the 1st sc to join;

Row 16-18 - sc around, sl st in the 1st sc to join;

Finish - Use yarn needle or small hook to weave in the ends.
