Ice cream sandwich pattern

Info

Materials

- crochet hook of your choice (I use 3.5mm)
- dark brown, white
- scissors
- stuffing
- sewing needle

Abbreviations - US terms

ch - chain

sc - single crochet

st - stitch

Cookie - Make 2

Ch 12

Rnd 1: Sc in 2nd ch and in every st across, two more sc in last ch (3 total), turn to work on reverse side of the ch, sc in each of the back of the ch, 2 sc in first ch (3 total) (24 st total)

Rnd 2-25 (24 ends): Sc around (24)

Add additional sc to edge of piece (should be about five but depends on tension



Tie off and cut leaving enough thread to sew the top closed, sew the top closed



Ice cream - make 1

Ch 69

Rnd 1 : Sc in first ch and then every ch around (69)

Rnd 2-5 (four rounds): sc around

After round 2 I suggest comparing your ice cream with your cookie to make sure your tension is not causing a diffrent size ice cream. If it is undo and adjust the starting ch.



Assembly

Sew the ice cream to one side of the sandwich.

Sew three sides of the top, stuff, finish sewing





Indents in cookie (optional) Sew through the bottom to the top and then go back down (make sure to go over a stitch so it doesn't just pull through). Pull tight and knot to make an indentation. Do this for every place you want an indentation.
