

# Mary Jane's TEAROOM

## 'BERRY BEAR HAT'

(Supplement)

The MjT 'Mossy Bear Hat' Knitting Pattern will be required to use alongside this alternative version of the original Hat.  
(Suitable for 20cm/8" Little Tearoom Bears)



### Yarn

**Jamieson's of Shetland 'Spindrift'** 4Ply/Fingering weight (details as original 'Mossy Bear Hat' Knitting Pattern)

**Yarn Amounts**    **MC Yarn A** approx. 5g    **CC Yarn B** 3m/3.3yds (see also Yarn Shades P.3)

### Knitting Needles

**Method 1 (in the round)** A set of Double Pointed Knitting Needles **3mm/US 2.5/UK 11**

**Method 2 (back & forth)** A pair of Single Pointed Knitting Needles **3mm/US 2.5/UK 11** plus 2 Double Pointed Knitting Needles of same size to knit mini I-cord (alternatively slip the stitches back to left needle after working each row)

# INSTRUCTIONS

~ Reading through the 'Mossy Bear Hat' knitting pattern is recommended before beginning ~

~ If printing enter specific page numbers to save ink/paper ~

~ Print in black & white to save coloured inks ~

~ Zoom in (+) on photographs for closer views if needed ~

### Method 1 'In the round' (for Method 2 see P.3)

Yarn **A**

**Rnds 1 - 27:** Work as for 'Mossy Bear Hat' Method 1

*Stalk Base ...*

Change to Yarn **B** (leaving 10cm/4" yarn ends in **A** & **B**)

**Rnds 28 - 31:** Continue now as for 'Mossy Bear Hat' Method 1  
(4 rnds) - 5sts remaining.

*Stalk ...*

Place **remaining stitches** onto **1 dpn** ready to knit **I-cord**

**Stalk** (**N1**2sts + **N2**2sts + **N3**1st - 5sts)

How to knit an I-cord ...

*Work I- cord as follows ...*

**Rnd 32:** K1, K2tog, K2 - 4sts

**Rnds 33 - 34:** K

**Rnd 35:** (K2tog) twice - 2sts

**Rnd 36:** K2tog

Break yarn leaving a 15cm/6" yarn end and pull through.

*To Finish ...*

Thread yarn end onto a blunt tapestry needle then take down through Stalk to WS. Darn in all yarn ends WS by using a sharp needle and skimming through purl stitches (except **cast on** yarn end which is secured on RS)

*Full your Hat ...*

'FULL' Hat as instructions for 'Mossy Bear Hat' Method 1 while taking care when shaping Stalk. Leave to dry completely.



## Method 2 'Back & Forth'

Yarn **A**

**Rows 1 - 26:** Work as for 'Mossy Bear Hat' Method 2

*Stalk Base ...*

Change to Yarn **B** (leaving a 10cm/4" yarn end in **A** and a 20cm/8" end in **B**)

**Rows 27 - 30:** Continue as for 'Mossy Bear Hat' Method 2 (beg WS) (4 rows) - 7sts remaining.

*Stalk ...*

**Row 31:** (P2tog) 3 times, P1 - 4sts (WS)

**Row 32:** K

Place remaining 4sts onto **1 dpn** (RS facing) ready to complete Stalk.

How to knit an I-cord ...

*Work I-cord as follows ...*

**Row 33:** K

**Row 34:** (K2tog) twice - 2sts

**Row 35:** K2tog

Break yarn leaving a 15cm/6" yarn end then pull through.



### Yarn Shades

(Left to Right)

#### MC

Yellow Ochre 230

Flame 271

Bramble 155

Sherbet 188

Salmon 301

#### CC

Granny Smith 1140

Rye 140



*To Finish ...*

Following 'Mossy Bear Hat' Method 2 use **cast on** yarn end **A** to join **centre back seam** in **mattress stitch** changing to yarn end **B** to join base seam of Stalk. Darn in yarn ends WS by using a sharp needle and lightly catching the purl stitches. Take **cast off** yarn end **B** down through Stalk to WS using a blunt tapestry needle then darn in as before.

*Full your Hat ...*

'FULL' Hat as instructions for 'Mossy Bear Hat'

**Method 2** while taking care when shaping Stalk. Leave to dry completely.
