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What You'll Need

Materials Needed:

Scrap worsted weight yarn

Poly-fill stuffing

18mm black safety eyes

Equipment Needed:

Size 2.75mm Crochet Hook

Scissors

Yarn needle

Stitch markers (optional)

Abbreviations: Pattern is in US Crochet Terms

ch: chain stitch

st: stitch

rnd: round (rounds are worked without turning chains, simply crochet in a spiral until the piece is completed.

slst: slip stitch

sc: single crochet

loop st: loop stitch

(*): when you see instructions written between parenthesis you will work these instructions as many times as the pattern tells you to.

inc: increase (crochet two stitches in the same stitch from last round)

dec: decrease (skip first st and work into second st from hook)

Body (make 1 in scrap yarn)

Rnd 1: start 8 sc in a magic ring [8]

Rnd 2: 8 loop st inc [16]

Rnd 3: (loop st inc, loop st) 8 times [24]

Rnd 4: (loop st inc, 2 loop st) 8 times [32]

Rnd 5-10: 32 loop st [32]

Eyes: Place eyes between rounds 7 and 8 with about 8 loop stitches between them or as many as desired.

Rnd 11: (loop st dec, 2 loop st) 8 times [24]

Rnd 12: (loop st dec, loop st) 8 times [16]

Note: stuff amigurumi at this time.

Rnd 13: loop st dec 8 times [8]

Sc in next st, slst in next st and fasten off. Take the yarn end and weave it into the front loop of every remaining stitch and pull tight to close the hole. weave yarn end into body and cut the remainder.

Styling the Fur

Cut all the loops from every loop stitch to create the hair. fluff up the hair and cut evenly. If you want you can take a cat's slicker brush to the hair, brushing in every direction for several minutes, to make it look fluffier.

Tail

Take three 12" strands of yarn and fold them in half so you have a loop on one end and 6 yarn ends on the other. pull the loop through a stitch on the Scrappy's behind and pull the 6 yarn ends through this loop and pull tightly. This is the start of the tail. Braid this as long as you like, tie a knot. Add beads if you desire. Tie a knot at the end and cut the remaining yarn leaving about half an inch which you can then brush to make fluffy.

Ears

Cut three more 12" strands of yarn and pull these through the top of the head where you want the first ear and pull them out where you want the second ear located. Tie a knot as close to the base of the head as possible to stop the ears from moving. Braid these and finish them the same way you did the tail.

Your Scrappy is now complete!
