

# Flower pillow

(Written pattern)

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# Materials used

1. Hook size: 6.00 mm
2. Yarn brand and size
3. Sorry for the unclear pictures. This yarn was gifted to me a very long time ago. So I have no idea from where it was bought or what size this yarn is.

So I posted some pictures down below. Hope this helps.

I used 50 grams for the petals (in light yellow color). And about 25 grams for the core (in light pink color). For each flower.

a. Brand of yarn



c. size of yarn



b. Type of yarn

100 % acrylic

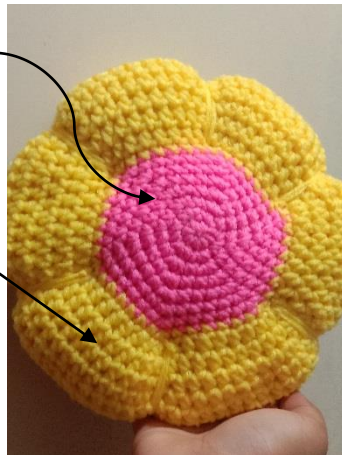


4. Needle: 3.5 inches



# Abbreviations used

- sc: single crochet
- hdc: half double crochet
- inc: increase
- dec: decrease
- hdc around: one hdc in each stitch until the end of the round
- Rnd: round
- Core of the flower
- petals

# Written pattern

*Start with your core color (I have used color pink)*

Make a magic ring

Rnd1: 6 sc in to the magic ring

Rnd2: [1 sc, inc] x 6

Rnd3: [2sc, inc] x 6

Rnd4: [3 sc, inc] x 6

Rnd5: [4 sc, inc] x 6

Rnd6: [5 sc, inc] x 6

Don't worry about crocheting a perfect circle for the core. The pointy edges from the core will help later to shape your petals.

Change color to petals (yellow)

Rnd7: [6 sc, inc] x 6

Rnd8: [7 hdc, inc] x 6

Rnd9: [8 hdc, inc] x 6

Rnd10: [9 hdc, inc] x 6

Rnd11: [10 hdc, inc] x 6

Rnd 12-14: hdc around (x 3 Rnd)

Rnd15: [10 hdc, dec] x 6

Rnd16: [9 hdc, dec] x 6

Rnd17: [8 hdc, dec] x 6

Rnd18: [7 hdc, dec] x 6

Rnd19: [6 sc, dec] x 6



Change color to core (pink) [leave a long tail when changing colors (petal color)]

Rnd20: [5 sc, dec] x 6

Rnd21: [4 sc, dec] x 6

Rnd22: [3 sc, dec] x 6

Rnd23: [2 sc, dec] x 6

Put stuffing in. do not over stuff. Put stuffing just enough to shape it.

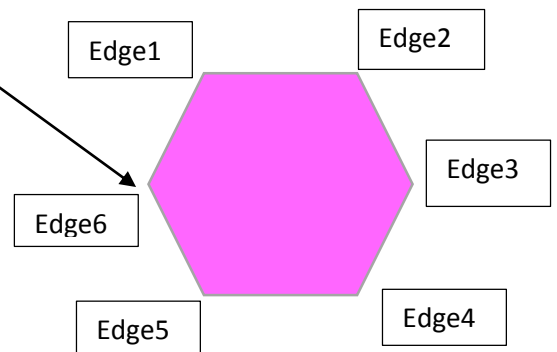
Rnd24: [1 sc, dec] x 6

Finish off

# Creating of the petals

Now to shape the petals. Pick the same color of the yarn used to make the petals (yellow). Pull yarn through the needle.

You will notice 6 edges from your core circle.



There are two sides to the flower. The Front and the back. Front side consists of inc stitches, and the back is where you dec the stitches.

**Note:**

The technique used to make the petals of the flower is the same technique used to make pumpkins.

### Step 1

- Pull your needle through one of the edges from the front of the flower and take your needle through to the other side. This is so that the two edges from both sides are aligned.



### Step 2

- a. Now take the yarn over the top of the petal



b. Insert the needle through the same spot as before.



c. now your yarn should look like this.



Step 3.

Tighten your yarn. This will create the bump to form your petals.

Repeats the 3 steps for three more times from the same edge. Make sure to tighten your yarn each time.

Weave your yarn a few times through the petal before taking your yarn from the next edge.

Then repeat the process 5 more times.

At the end you shall have 6 petals.
