

Round Bottom Flask Amigurumi

Difficulty: Beginner

(not my videos, but v helpful!)

worked in the round

sc = [single crochet](#)

blo = [back loop only](#)



any yarn/color, use recommended size hook;

but use same yarn size for both colors

for stuffing, you can buy polyfill, but I usually buy a \$3-5 pillow at a [Big Box Store] and cut it open for the stuffing. ends up being cheaper (and more convenient, storing large bags of polyfill can be a nuisance)

with reaction color:

[magic circle](#)

row 1 6 sc into magic circle

row 2 2 sc into each sc from prev round (12)

row 3 1 sc into first stitch, then 2 sc into next stitch. repeat until end of round (18)

row 4 1 sc into first two stitches, then 2 sc into next stitch. repeat until end of round. (24)

row 5 1 sc into first 3 stitches, then 2 sc into next stitch. repeat until end of round (30)

row 6 1 sc into first 4 stitches, then 2 sc into next stitch. repeat until end of round. (36)

row 7 1 sc into 1st 11 stitches, then 2 sc into next stitch. repeat until end of round (39)

row 8

row 9

row 10 1 sc around for 4 rounds (39x4)

row 11

fasten off or weave in end. switch to white – [switching colors](#)

row 12

row 13 1 sc in each stitch around for 3 rounds (39x3)

row 14

insert safety eyes wherever you think they look cute 😊 - [safety eyes](#)

row 15 1 sc in eleven stitches, then two together. repeat until the end of the round. (36)

row 16 1sc into 4 stitches, then 2 together. repeat until the end of the round. (30)

row 17 1 sc into 3 stitches, then 2 together. repeat until the end of the round. (24)

partially stuff

row 18 1 sc into 2 stitches, then 2 together. repeat until the end of the round. (18)

row 19 1 sc into first stitch then 2 together. repeat until the end of the round. (12)

row 20 1 sc blo around (12)

row 21 sc around for 4 rounds (12x4)

row 22 1 sc blo around

fasten off, stuff! i left the neck unstuffed for maximum authenticity.
