The square pattern is 25 stitches wide and 25 stitches tall. The regular flag pattern is 50 stitches wide and 25 stitches tall. The circle pattern is 16 rounds of single crochet.

There are no materials requirements. The patterns are simply the smallest the flag can be while accurately maintaining the stripe proportions. You can use a hook and yarn of any size to make the flag the size of your choice. Pictured on the right, I used embroidery thread for the circle pattern; in the middle, also embroidery thread, but the square pattern; and on the bottom, needlepoint for the normal pattern.
