Very Berry Cup Cozy





Supplies

Worsted weight yarn (recommended: Lily Sugar'n Cream, 25-28 grams)

4.5 mm crochet hook

Button

Scissors and tapestry needle

Jerms

BS - berry stitch (YO, insert hook into stitch, YO, pull through, YO, pull through only one loop on hook, YO, insert hook into same stitch, YO, pull through, YO, pull through all five loops on the hook; here's a video tutorial by Daisy Farm Crafts)

HDC - half double crochet

SC - single crochet

SS - slip stitch

Gauge

10 SC stitches and 10 rows = 3 in x 2.5 in (7 cm x 3 cm)

Finished Measurements

3.5 in x 10.5 in, not including button hole section (8 cm x 26 cm)

Pattern

Chain 38

Row 1: Beginning in 2nd chain from hook, SC in each chain across (37 SCs). Chain 1 and turn.

Row 2: *SC in next stitch, BS in next stitch* repeat * * 17 times. SC in last stitch. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 3: SC in each stitch across. Chain 6 and turn.

Row 4: Beginning in 2nd chain from hook, SC in next 5 chains. *SC in next stitch, BS in next stitch* repeat * * 17 times.

SC in last stitch. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 5: SC in 39 stitches across. Chain 3 then SC in last stitch (skip 3 stitches). Chain 1 and turn.

Row 6: SC in next 5 stitches.*SC in next stitch, BS in next stitch* repeat * * 17 times. SC in last stitch. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 7: SC in 38 stitches across. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 8: *SC in next stitch, BS in next stitch* repeat * * 17 times. SC in last stitch. Chain 1 and turn.

Row 9: SC in each stitch across.

Edging:

Beginning in the last stitch of Row 9, SS down the side in each row and around the button hole. HDC in each stitch across the bottom. SS up the side in each row. HDC in each stitch across the top. Be sure to include 1 SS and 1 HDC in each corner and in working order. Fasten off and weave ends.

Finishing:

Add a button on row 5 (ensure the button is on the BS side).
