# LITTLE FISHERMAN'S BEANIE

## **MATERIALS**

50g Drops Flora: 13 - Jeansblue 25g Drops Brushed Alpaca Silk: 25 - Steel blue

2 thread of Flora and 1 thread of Brushed Alpaca Silk held together.

5.5mm circular knitting needles, 40cm 6mm circular knitting needles, 40cm stitch markers tapestry needle

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

K	knit
р	purl
St(s)	stitch(es)
k2tog	knit 2 together
ssk	slip, slip, knit
stm	stitch marker


## **GAUGE**

12 sts and 22 rows = 10cm in 1x1 rib stitch (6mm needles)









#### HEM

2 thread of Flora and 1 thread of Brushed Alpaca Silk held together.

Cast on 60 sts (with any method you like, I recommend long tail cast on) with 5.5mm needles. Put a stitch marker on the beginning of the row. Knit 8 rows.

Now, fold these 8 rows so purl stitches would stay inside. You have the cast-on edge and the latest row side by side. With 6mm needles knit together one stitch from the cast-on edge with one stitch from the latest row, then purl together one stitch from the cast-on edge with one stitch from the latest row - starting the 1x1 rib.

#### **BODY**

Knit in rib until the garment is 17 cm long. - If you prefer a bigger hem, knit 5 more cm in rib sts.

#### CROWN

Now starts the crown - from here knit stockinette sts.

Knit 7 sts, place a stm, knit 1 st, place a stm. >> Knit 14 sts, place a stm, knit 1 st, place a stm

>> Repeat 2 more times. Now the beanie divided into 4 parts.

Decrease in every second row with the following method: ssk before stm, knit 1, k2tog after stm.

When you have decreased to 14 sts, knit one more row, then k2tog the complete next row - 7 sts on the needle. Cut the yarn (leave a long tail), pull it through the remaining sts, tighten properly and weave in at the wrong side.

Weave in the ends and block as desired.
