Winged Knits

Winged

SIZE: One Size

Finished Measurement: 20" stretched circumference

MATERIALS:

Princess by **Classic Elite Yarns** (40% merino, 28% viscose, 10% cashmere, 10% nylon, 7% angora; 50 gram ball = approx 150 yards)

- 1 ball 3427 Cotes de Rhone
- (Optional) Small amount of yarn for embroidery.

Needles:

- One 16" circular size US 4 (3.5 mm)
- One set of double pointed needles (dpns) size US 4 (3.5 mm)

Or size to obtain gauge.

GAUGE: 23 sts and 40 rows = 4" in Seed Stitch. Take time to save time, check your gauge.

ABBREVIATIONS:

k2tog: Knit 2 stitches together (1 st decreased).

STITCH PATTERNS:

1 x 1 Rib (mult of 2 sts):

All rnds: *K1, p1; rep from * around.

Seed Stitch (mult of 2 sts):

Rnd 1: *K1, p1; rep from * around. Rnd 2: *P1, k1; rep from * around. Rep Rnds 1 and 2 for Seed St.

Stockinette Stitch: Knit all rnds.

HAT

With circular needle, CO 104 sts. Place marker (pm) for begin of rnd (BOR) and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Begin 1 x 1 Rib and work even until meas ¾ ". Change to Seed St and work even for 4 rows. Change to St st and inc 14 sts evenly across this rnd- 118 sts. Work even until pc meas 3" from CO edge. Change to Seed St and work even until pc meas 6 ¼ " from CO edge, end after Rnd 2 of Seed St. Next rnd: P2tog, *k1, p1; rep from * to end- 117 sts.

Shape Crown, next rnd, set up rnd: *Work 7 sts in Seed St as est, k2tog, pm; rep from * around. (BOR marker counts as last marker.) Next Rnd, Rnd 1: *Work in Seed St to 1 st before m, k1, slip marker (sl m); rep from * around. Rnd 2 (dec rnd): *Work in Seed St to 2 sts before m, k2tog, sl m; rep from* around. Rep last 2 rnds until 1 st remains between markers- 13 sts rem. Next rnd: (removing markers)*K2tog; rep from * to last st, k1- 7 sts rem. Cut yarn leaving a 6" tail, with tapestry needle thread yarn through remaining sts. Pull tight to close top of hat.

Finishing:

Block piece. (Optional) Embroidery in St st portion: With tapestry needle and second color yarn, work chart using duplicate stitch for heart and backstitch for wings.
